Nomination reference to Community Service Award is to be published in *Briefly Stated*, the bimonthly newsletter of the Georgia Academy of Family Physicians. Nominations will be reviewed by the Membership Committee and will make a recommendation to the Board of Directors. If no member is nominated or selected as a winner, no award will be given.
