- Text in Arial Regular, white
- Title - 40-72 point; Subtitle - 36-48 point; Presenter and Date - 24 point.

## Inside Slides

- Text in Arial Regular, black.
- Headline - 36-48 point; Body copy - 18-32 point.

## Disclaimer Slide

- Use when presentation contains AAFP content.

## Closing Slide

- Must appear as last slide for all PowerPoint presentations.
